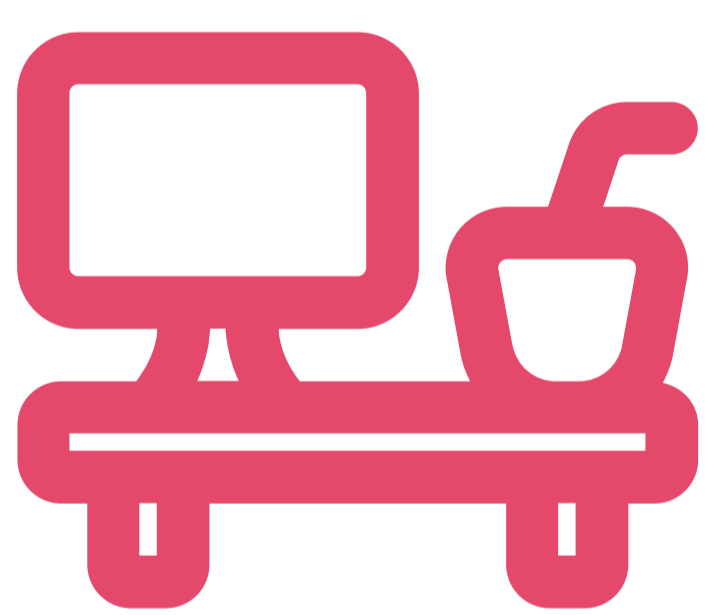

EMPLOYEES PREFER FULLY REMOTE OR HYBRID REGIMES
